
Essential's of Music Theory


How to get there...

- 1. Click on 'Start' and go to 'All Programs'
- 2. Click on 'Network Applications and go to 'Music'
- 3. Click on Essentials of Theory v1



Logging in...

1. Click on user Log In



- 2. Find your name in the student list and click on your name
- 3. Enter your password (student id number do not add an extra 0 before your id number)
- 4. Click on Log in



Navigating...

Menu: Takes you to the various units and lessons the program offers. There are 6 units and 36 lessons. First click on the Unit you are currently working on and then click on the lesson number to begin the program.

Terms: This takes you to the glossary of the program. You can look up any term(s) that you might need refreshing on or might be unsure of. You can access the glossary while in the middle of a lesson. Just click on the 'Terms' icon on the left-hand side of the screen or on any of the blue highlighted words and the program will take you to the glossary.

Scores: This is where you go to check your progress and grades on the the reviews for each unit. You will only be able to see your scores. From this page you can get detailed information about your test scores as well as print your test results.

General Notes...

- You do not need to complete all the lessons prior to taking the review. However, you do need to complete the review in order to get credit for completing that unit level of theory.
- You are required to complete the ear-training in every unit.
- The navigation buttons (Menu, Terms, Scores, Quit) will always be on the screen. You can use them at any given time.
- You must have headphones to use the program.
